Postgraduate Photographic Celebration Rules

- 1. You must be currently enrolled in an MPhil, MRes or PhD in Social Anthropology at the University of Cambridge.
- 2. You must firstly register your intention to enter into the celebration by Friday 5 April 2024 and then subsequently submit up to three photographs showing your fieldwork, including a title and short caption for each photograph and a short account of your fieldwork of up to 200 words. Submissions of photographs will be to the dedicated Moodle course.
- 3. It is the responsibility of those submitting photographs to ensure that the images they provide are appropriate for public display and would not create difficulty or embarrassment, including problems for any persons depicted.
- 4. Photographs must be submitted in high-resolution jpeg images suitable for digital reproduction.
- 5. By submitting your work, you agree to its public display within the Department, use on the Department's website, in the Haddon library and display at a limited number of University outreach events. In the event of display of your images you will need to confirm that you have got the subject's permission for display.
- 6. All photography entries must be submitted by 5:00pm, Friday 26 April 2024.
