soon after you return to Cambridge in Easter Term.

Easter Term – make sure you have typed up a draft of the SAN

FORM1 Proposal to Offer a Dissertation – various people need to read it, agree with it and sign it (e.g. your assigned Supervisor, your Director of Studies) so make sure you do this early to give them time to consider your
